Large grocery store with wide selection: fresh produce, meats, deli, bakery, sushi, hot meals, prepared foods, organic products — great for full grocery rups. (Tip: Wegman's has a great appl)

Food, Restaurants & Student-Friendly Eats

If you're a student or just want casual, affordable eats / takeout / easy hangouts, these areas and spots are popular:

- **Collegetown, Ithaca** this neighborhood near campus is packed with restaurants, cafes, and student-friendly services.
- Favorites in/near Collegetown: Visit Ithaca+1
 - Bagels, sandwiches, coffee at Collegetown Bagels
 - International / student-budget restaurants like Dos Amigos & Tres Leches (Cali-Mex / casual food)
 - Late-night, budget-conscious or grab-and-go meals are common in this area good for busy students or residents. <u>Cornell Arts & Sciences+1</u>
- <u>Downtown Ithaca Commons</u> shops, restaurants, cafes, nightlife, and a hub for social life beyond campus. Great for exploring, meeting friends, night-outs, and local events.

Getting Around & Transit
